More Hints From Your Hauler

Recycling (and yard debris, if you have that service) is picked up every other week on the same day your garbage is picked up. Refer to the enclosed schedule or visit www.sanipac.com/residential. Some other tips:

- Bag dust and lightweight items that might blow out of the truck.
- Danger - hot ashes in a container can melt them or start fires!
- Place all items at the curb by 7 a.m. on your designated day.
- Please remember that our truck's clamp needs room to move. Keep your containers 4 feet from each other and other obstacles such as trees or cars.

Yard Debris

If you have yard debris service, the carts are collected every other week, opposite the recycling schedule. We can only accept things that grow above the ground, and they must be loose. Do not bag yard debris. We cannot accept items like rocks, soil or pet waste because they contaminate the yard debris.
